NOTIFICATION OF STATUS:

- Academic Reference Form from an English, Math, Science, or Social Studies Teacher
(This form must be sealed and returned by January 6, 2012).

FOR 9TH GRADE ADMISSION:

- A copy of all district and state achievement test scores for the 7th grade year.
- The student's report card for the end of the 7th grade year.
- A copy of the student's 8th grade report card (most recent cycle).

FOR 10TH GRADE ADMISSION:

- A copy of all district and state achievement test scores for the 8th grade year.
- The student's end of year report card for the 8th grade year.
- A copy of the student's 9th grade report card (most recent cycle).
- An unofficial copy of the student's current transcript.

FOR ALL ADMISSION:

- Individual Education Plan (IEP)
- 504
- Special Education (ARD)
- ESL/LEP
- Gifted/Talented

ALL materials must be returned by January 6, 2012.

NOTE: Missing documents may result in revocation of acceptance at the discretion of the CECHS Administration.
